Mid-Nov.	TIF annual reports due to DED. Penalty for failing to file report is loss of ability to implement new TIFs for 5 years	§99.865 (deadline set annually by DED)

Early Dec.	Publish newspaper notice of opening filing date for municipal office, the offices to be filled, the proper place for filing and the closing filing date of the election (No date specified except "before 16 th Tuesday before Municipal Election Day"; can be done at an early date)	§115.127.5
Mid-Dec. (16 th Tues. before Municipal Election Day)	Opening of filing period for municipal elective office.	§115.127.5
*Dec. 31 (6 mo. after end of fiscal year)	File City's Annual Financial Report with State Auditor (if filing an audited financial report prepared by a CPA) (<i>Also required for other "political subdivisions" that may be administered by City; i.e., TDDs or CIDs</i>)	§105.145 & 15 CSR 40-3.030
